



Role Outline: Zero-5k Crew Co-ordinator

COMMITMENT/DURATION: Elected position for the membership year

PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE REQUIRED: None

Role Purpose:

The primary responsibility of the Zero-5k Crew Co-ordinator is to lead the Club's Zero-5k programme and associated activities.

Typical Responsibilities:

- Co-ordination and promotion of Zero-5k programmes
- Attendance at Zero-5k sessions, with a leading responsibility
- Co-ordination of run leaders to support the delivery of Zero-5k sessions
- Management of Zero-5k inbox, including communicating to members and interested parties
- Co-ordination of Zero-5k graduation event, including liaising with parkrun, sourcing buddies, medals etc
- Reporting on the outcomes of Zero-5k programmes to the committee
- Liaising with relevant local partners on their engagement, with a view to referrals for Zero-5k programmes
